Zoom for Healthcare Information

On March 15, 2020 the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) of the US Department of Health and Human Services issued formal Notice providing the following: Effective <u>immediately</u> and throughout the COVID-19 national emergency, *our providers may use non-public remote communications technologies to provide telehealth services* in order to provide screening and treatment of patients safely and expeditiously.

What technologies are included?

Providers may use any <u>nonpublic-facing</u> audio or video chat application in order to communicate with their patient. They include the following HIPAA-compliant technologies:

- Apple Facetime
- Facebook Messenger
- Skype for Business
- Updox
- VSee
- Zoom for Health
- Doxy.me
- Google G Suite Hangouts Meet

What technologies are not included?

Providers are <u>not</u> permitted to use <u>public-facing</u> applications (e.g., Facebook Live, Twitch, Tiktok) in order to communicate with their patients, as they are not HIPAA-compliant.
